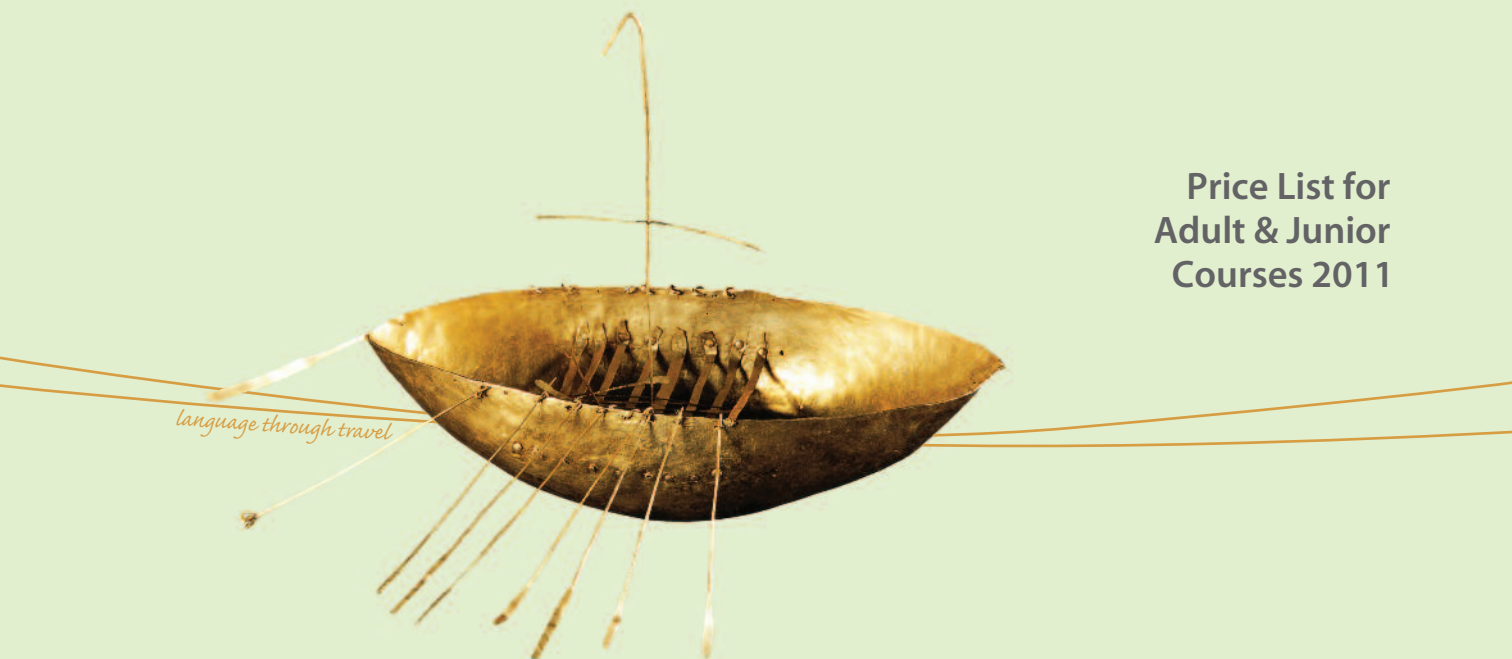

Terms & Conditions for Adult Courses 2011

1. Age

Minimum age for our adult school is 18 years old

2. Classes

Each class hour is 60 minutes

3. Fees

- Fees include: tuition, welcome pack, student information handbook, use of computers, placement test and end of course certificate
- Fees do not include: Exam fees, lunch, private insurance and bank charges
- A registration fee of €50 will be charged on all courses
- All students must pay for their course books at a cost of €30 per book. The fee for the first book is included on the invoice.

4. Airport Transfers

We can arrange for you to be met at Dublin Airport and taken by car to your accommodation. The cost of this service is €75. The transfer service is available between 08.00-22.00 and is available on arrival only. It may be possible to arrange a transfer outside these hours, in which case a supplement of €30 is payable.

5. IH Dublin Calendar

The School will be closed on the following public holidays:

- Christmas Holidays 2010, school will be closed for 2 weeks from December 17th 2010 and will re-open on January 3rd 2011
- Christmas Holidays 2011, school will be closed for 2 weeks from December 16th and will re-open on January 2nd 2012
- St Patrick's Day – Thursday March 17th
- Easter Monday – April 25th (Course start date is Tuesday April 26th)

Please note that:

- No lessons will take place on above days
- There is no reduction in fees when a course includes a public holiday and classes are not compensated for

There will be an Orientation Day at the school on the following public holidays, including testing and a tour of the city centre:

- May Bank Holiday – May 2nd
- June Bank Holiday – June 6th

- August Public Holiday – August 1st
- October Bank Holiday – October 31st

Please note that:

- All students should come to school for 11am on the above days for a level test and orientation tour
- No lessons will take place on the above days
- There is no reduction in fees when a course includes a public holiday and classes are not compensated for

6. Accommodation

All accommodation booked by IH Dublin is subject to a booking fee of €50.

Homestay

- Based on 7 nights stay, beginning from Saturday or Sunday
- Options include half-board Monday-Friday and full board at weekends or breakfast only
- Located in suburbs of Dublin – average of 40-50 minutes bus ride to the school, though this may be longer at peak traffic times

Self-catering Apartment

- Based on 7 nights, beginning only from Sunday
- Self-catering, no meals included

Accommodation during Christmas Holidays

- It is possible to stay in your host family during the Christmas holidays for an cost of €50 per week
- It is possible to stay in your self-catering apartment during the Christmas holidays at no extra cost

7. Insurance

- All students are advised to take out private medical and travel insurance
- All EU nationals should bring a European Health Insurance Card which covers public medical care

8. Visas

Non EU nationals should contact their local Irish Embassy or Consulate or visit the Department of Justice website www.justice.ie for details of visa requirements. IH Dublin offers an efficient visa support service.

9. Payment

Full payment of fees is due 2 weeks prior to the starting date. Payment can be made by any of the following ways:

Important Payment Notes

- Bank charges are not included in the fees and must be paid by the sender
- Payment is due **two weeks** before the start of the booked course.
- Please always state student's name and invoice number on bank transfer

10. Cancellation

- If a course is cancelled more than 14 days before the start date, the registration fee of €50 will be charged.
- If a course is cancelled less than 14 days before the start date, one week's tuition will be charged
- If host family accommodation is cancelled less than 14 days before arrival date, one week's accommodation will be charged.
- If self-catering apartment is cancelled less than 4 weeks before arrival date, one week's accommodation will be charged.
- If a cancellation occurs because of a visa refusal, the registration fee of €50 will be charged. In the case of a visa refusal, the refund will be processed when the official letter of refusal from immigration is sent to IH Dublin.
- Please note that all cancellations must be sent to us in writing (by post or e-mail)

12. Refunds

No refunds can be made after a course has started. In the case of illness, students may ask for a course to be postponed to a later date. In this case the school will require a medical certificate. A course cannot be carried over to the next calendar year.

1. Age

Junior Programmes available for students aged 11-17 years old

2. Classes

Each class hour is 60 minutes. There are 15 lessons per week.

3. Fees

Package included in above fees:

- 15 hours tuition in mixed nationality classes
- Full-board host family or college accommodation
- Hot lunch at school in Homestay Centre
- Private daily transport to and from Homestay Centre
- Afternoon activities Monday-Friday and 1 disco per week in Homestay Centre
- Afternoon and evening activities every day in Residential Centre
- 1 full day excursion per week
- All course materials, placement test and end of course certificate

Package Fees do not include:

- Private insurance, bank charges or airport transfers

4. Accommodation

Homestay Programme Sutton Park School

Accommodation is in a twin room, shared with another student of a different nationality

Residential Programme Deer Park Resort

Accommodation is in large shared bedrooms (3-4 students). All rooms have a TV, lounge area and private bathroom.

5. Airport Transfers

All junior students must book return airport transfers with IH Dublin. Transfers outside of the hours 08.00 – 22.00 will be subject to a supplement of €30 per transfer.

If you are being accompanied by an adult/guardian from the airport and do not require an airport transfer, please notify us in advance of your arrival time.

6. Public Holidays

August 1st is a public holiday in Ireland

Please note that: No lessons take place on August 1st and a full-day excursion is organised. Classes for that week start on Tuesday August 2nd.

7. Insurance

Students are advised to take out private medical and travel insurance. All EU nationals should also bring a European Health Insurance Card which covers public medical care.

8. Visas

Non EU nationals should contact their local Irish Embassy or Consulate or visit the Department of Justice website www.justice.ie for details of visa requirements. IH Dublin offers an efficient visa support service.

9. Cancellation

- If a course is cancelled more than 14 days before the start date, a registration fee of €50 will be charged
- If a course is cancelled less than 14 days before the start date, one week's programme will be charged (divide 2 week course price by 2 to obtain 1 week price)
- No refunds can be made after a course has started
- If a cancellation occurs because of a visa refusal, a registration fee of €50 will be charged. In the case of a visa refusal, the refund will be

processed when the official letter of refusal from immigration is sent to IH Dublin.

- Please note that all cancellations must be sent to us in writing (by post or e-mail)

10. Refunds

No refunds can be made after a course has started. In the case of illness, students may ask for a course to be postponed to a later date. In this case the school will require a medical certificate. If a course is carried over to the next calendar year, there may be an extra fee payable.

11. Deposit and Payment
